Our 'Book Week' will run from Monday 27th February to Friday 3rd March and already a number of events have been booked for the week. On Friday (3rd) the children are invited to come to school dressed as a book character, hopefully bringing with them the book that the character comes from. They will receive a World Book Day Token to spend on a book of their choice and we are delighted that a handful of parents, who have had experience writing books or working in the field of journalism are coming along to talk to the children at different points during the week.
